Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any writ order or direction more in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the 2nd respondent in going ahead with Voting In elections pursuant to election notification dt.5/9/21 for the Post of President, Telangana Government Drivers Central Association, Hyderabad, inspite of petitioners representation dt.19/9/21 along with copy of report issued by the Office of Municipal Corporation of Karimnagar, dt. 28/8/2018, which disqualifies the 3rd respondent from contesting the elections, as illegal, arbitrary, malicious and contrary to the Bye laws of the Association, and consequently stay all further proceedings pursuant to the Election notification dt.5/9/2021 including issuing of proceedings to the 3rd respondent and handing over of charge to the 3rd respondent.

Petition under Section 151 CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased till date proceedings declaring the 3rd respondent as winner are not issued by the 2nd respondent herein nor the charge is handed over to him pursuant to the election

conducted on 19/9/2021. Hence it is prayed that this Honourable court may be pleased to direct the 2nd respondent herein not to issue proceedings to the 3rd respondent and not to hand over the charge of the office of President, Telangana Government Drivers Central Association, Hyderabad, to the 3rd respondent, pursuant to election conducted on 19/9/2021, pending disposal of the writ petition.
