Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the record. This Court on 14.12.2021 while granting bail to the petitioner/Accused No.2, directed the petitioner to execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- with two sureties for a like sum each. Taking into consideration the submission of learned counsel for petitioner, this petition is allowed and the surety amount of Rs.1,00,000/- is reduced to Rs.50,000/-. 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		Petitioner was granted interim relief on the ground that he shall pay complete outstanding liability of Rs.14,85,000/-. The petitioner states that he failed to make payment of the amount undertaken before this Court. However, due to the petitioner being in jail in connection with some other crime, the petitioner failed to pay the outstanding amount. Now the petitioner seeks further time of two weeks for making payment of the outstanding amount undertaken before this court.
