ORDER:

This Criminal Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., is filed by the petitioners/A4 and A5 seeking to quash the proceedings in C.C.No.3697 of 2020 on the file of the V Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Warangal, registered for the offences under Sections 498-A IPC and under Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, against them.

2. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners/A4 and A5, learned Additional Public Prosecutor representing the 1st respondent-State and perused the record.

3. Though the petitioners have raised several grounds to quash the proceedings in the aforesaid case, learned counsel for the petitioners requested this Court to dispense with the appearance of the petitioners/A4 and A5 in the aforesaid case before the trial Court.

4. Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor submits that since the identity of petitioners is not in dispute, their presence in the above case may not be necessary on every date of adjournment.

5. In view of the aforesaid submissions, the appearance of the petitioners/A4 and A5 in C.C.No.3697 of 2020 on the file of V Additional Judicial First Class Magistrate, Warangal, is dispensed with, except on the dates whenever their presence is required by the trial Court and they shall be represented by their counsel.

6. With the above direction, the Criminal Petition is disposed of.

7. Miscellaneous petitions, if any pending in this criminal petition,
shall stand closed.
