ORDER: *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Satish Chandra Sharma)*

The present contempt case is arising out of order dated 07.03.2019 passed in W.P.No.284 of 2019 by this Court.

This Court has directed the competent authority to take appropriate action in respect of the recommendations sent by the High Court for grant of higher pay scales to the Members of petitioner's Association. As the same was not done, the present contempt petition was preferred.

A detailed reply has been filed in the matter. The reply reveals that the State Government has rejected the proposal by an order dated 19.02.2021. Meaning thereby, the order passed by this Court has already been complied with and therefore, no further orders are required to be passed in the matter.

Accordingly, the contempt case is closed with a liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh contempt case in case the petitioner is still aggrieved in the matter.

Miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
