Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus to declare the impugned proceedings of Lr.RC.No.D1/5980/2006-1, dated 15.02.2011 and the action of the respondents 1 to 7 in not releasing the Scholarship amount to the SC & ST students who are studying in 8th & 9th respondent school pertaining to the academic year 2011-2012 against the representation of the petitioner dated 13.12.2011 is as illegal, malafide, derelictions of duties and contrary to the G.O.Ms.No.182, Social Welfare (Q2) Department dated 23.08.1991 & G.O.Rt.No.329, Social Welfare (Q) Department, dated 21.05.1993 and consequentially by setting aside the same direct the official respondents to forth take action to see the students belonging to SC & ST Community studying in 8th and 9th respondent who have not paid the prescribed fee be permitted to attend the classes regularly and be allowed for examinations

ORDER: *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Satish Chandra Sharma)*

The present public interest litigation was filed in the year 2012 by the Telangana SC & ST Parents Association of Hyderabad Public Schools stating that the respondent State is not releasing scholarship amount to the SC & ST students in time in respect of the academic year 2011-2012.

The academic year 2011-2012 is already over and therefore, no further orders are required to be passed in the present case. However, the State Government is directed to ensure distribution of scholarship amount in time to all eligible students for the future academic years also.

The public interest litigation is accordingly disposed of. The miscellaneous applications pending, if any, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
