Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondents in not receiving the application form and not releasing the power supply to the petitioner House Bearing Plot No.176 in Sy.No.5P 6P 7P, admeasuring 620 sq yards, Situated at Guttala Begumpet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, Ranga Reddy District as illegal, null, void, arbitrary and consequently direct the respondents to release the power supply without being influenced by the instructions of the 5th respondent.

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed aggrieved by the inaction of the respondents in receiving the application and releasing the power supply to the petitioner's house constructed in Plot No.176 in Sy.No.5P, 6P and 7P admeasuring 620 sq. yards situated at Guttala Begumpet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, Ranga Reddy District.

2. When the matter is taken up, it is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the issue raised in the present Writ Petition is squarely covered by the orders passed by this Court in WP.No.26401 of 2021 dt.25.10.2021 and WP.No.21100 of 2019 dt.25.09.2019.

3. Sri R. Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Telangana State Power Distribution Company Limited appearing for respondents 1 to 4 and Sri Sampath Prabhakar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation, appearing for respondent No.5, do not dispute the aforesaid submission.

In view of the above, and for reasons alike in the said order, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to receive the application of the petitioner and release service connection to the petitioner within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, and the same shall be subject to further direction that may be

ORDER:

This Writ Petition is filed for the following relief:

“... to issue an appropriate Writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents to act in accordance with law and to provide service connections along with electrical metres to the building constructed on Plot bearing No.879, admeasuring 333 Sq. Yards in Sy. No.11/14 to 11/18 Part of Sy. No.11 situated in Sri Swamy Ayyappa Cooperative Housing Society Limited, Khanamet village, Serilingampally Mandal, R.R. District, without being influenced by the instructions of the 5th respondent....”

When the matter is taken up, it is submitted by the learned Counsel for the petitioner that the issue raised in the present Writ Petition is squarely covered by the order dated 25.09.2019 passed by this Court in W.P. No.21100 of 2019.

Learned Government Pleader appearing for Energy/respondent No.1, Sri R. Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Telangana State Power Distribution Company Limited appearing for respondents 2 to 4 and Sri Sampath Prabhakar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation, appearing for respondent No.5, do not dispute the aforesaid submission.

In view of the above, for the reasons alike in the said order, this Writ Petition is disposed of directing the respondents to release individual service connection to the petitioner within a period of four (4) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, and the

same shall be subject to further direction that may be issued by the State of Telangana or the Apex Court in the litigation pending before it arising out of the order dated 12.09.2012 in Writ Petition No.20407 of 2008 and batch. No costs.

Miscellaneous petitions pending if any, shall stand closed.

WRIT PETITION No.21100 OF 2019

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed aggrieved by action of respondents in not receiving the application and not releasing the power supply to the petitioner's house at premises bearing Plot No.350, admeasuring 417 square yards in Sy.No.11/14 to 11/18 situated at Khanamet Village, Serilingampally Mandal, Ranga Reddy District.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in similar circumstances, this Court disposed of WP.No.22849 of 2018, dated 05-07-2018.

Heard Sri R.Vinod Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for respondents 2 to 5 and Sri Sampath Prabhakar Reddy, learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.6.

In view of the same, for the reasons alike in the said order, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents to receive the application of the petitioner for electric power supply connection by complying all the norms as required by the respondent-Company. As and when such application is made, the respondent-Company is directed to provide individual service connection to the petitioner within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of such application and

provision of such power supply connection shall be subject to further direction that may be issued by the State of Telangana or the Supreme Court in the litigation pending before it arising out of the judgment dated 12-09-2012 in WP.No.20407 of 2008 and batch. Pending miscellaneous applications if any shall stand closed.
