Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue order or direction more particularly one in the Writ of Mandamus, to set aside Letter dt.27.06.2015 of 1st respondent by declaring the action of the 1st respondent in denying the admission in 5 year under graduate course in the Common Law Admission Test 2015 (CLAT 2015) to the Petitioner in the 1st respondent University as illegal, arbitrary and contrary to S.5.02 C(i) of Statute V of 1st respondent University apart from violation of principles of natural justice and consequently direct the 1st respondent University to admit the Petitioner in 5 years under graduate course in the CLAT 2015 as per the "Resident Student and Schedule Tribe reservation".

ORDER:

When the matter is taken up for hearing, counsel appearing for the petitioner had contended that the present writ petition is filed by the petitioner challenging the action of the respondents in denying admission of the petitioner into 5 years under graduate course in Nalsar University of Law, and this Court, while admitting the writ petition on 30.06.2015, passed interim order directing the 1st respondent to admit the petitioner and permit her to attend the classes subject to payment of requisite fee, and also set aside the impugned order dated 27.06.2015. Counsel further submitted that in view of the said interim order, the cause in the writ petition does not survive and the writ petition may be closed.

In view of the above submission, this Court is of the considered view that the cause in the writ petition does not survive and the writ petition is, accordingly, closed. No order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
