COMMON ORDER: *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Hima Kohli)*

On the last date of hearing, learned counsel for the respondent/wife sought time to obtain instructions from his client in respect of the compromise that the other side had stated had been arrived between the parties. Today, he states that he has obtained instructions from his client that the parties have arrived at a settlement in terms of Memorandum of Compromise dated 02.07.2021 and therefore, he has no objection to the present appeal being disposed of.
