The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to get detenues mentioned in para 2 of the petition, released from the illegal custody of respondents No.4 and 5.

Vide order dated 01.01.2020, this Court directed the appointment of a Warrant Officer to visit the place of detention of the alleged detenues, to record their statements and get them released, in case they are found to be in illegal confinement of respondents No.4 and 5 and to submit a report before this Court. The Warrant Officer has submitted his report, wherein he has stated as under:-

“ In compliance to the orders of the Hon'ble Court dt. 01.01.2020, It is fairly submitted that undersigned alongwith petitioner and police party of the Police Station Julana Distt. Jind reached at Shiv Brick Kiln situated in the area of the Village Khema Kheri and 19 laborers including men, women and children (were) freed and custody (was) given to the petitioner alongwith their belongings who left the Brick Kiln in a canter bearing number HR 56A 0019 (Flag 'Y'), which was arranged by the petitioner himself. Respondent No.4 the Brick Kiln owner (has) not objected the release of the labour. Undersigned accompanied them upto Jind. ”

In view of the above report, counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.

Permitted to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
