This criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondent Nos.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, who are apprehending threats at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7.

On 04.01.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:

Learned State counsel prays for time to verify the facts and the existence of alleged threat.

On his request, adjourned to 11.01.2021. ”

Today learned State counsel has produced the statements of the

petitioners and stated that as on today, they are not facing any threat and do not need any protection.

In view of the statements of the petitioners, nothing survives for adjudication in the present case.

The petition is dismissed.
