RAJAN GUPTA, J. (Oral)

Case has been heard through Video Conferencing on account of COVID-19 Pandemic.

After arguing at some length, Mr. Sharma prays that he may be allowed to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file an appeal before the DRAT. He, however, submits that the property which is a running school may not be seized for a period of ten days to enable him to avail remedy of appeal.

Writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. It is directed that the property of the petitioner would not be seized for a period of ten days from today. This limited concession would, however, have no bearing on the merits of the case as the appellate body will decide the case in view of the provisions of the statute and the facts and circumstances of the case.
