The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID-19.

Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 0030 dated 11.07.2018 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala, and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion was issued. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No.2 appeared.

Vide order dated 08.01.2021, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 18.01.2021 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 19.01.2021 of learned JMIC, Patiala, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned JMIC, Patiala and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 0030 dated 11.07.2018 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Patiala, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
