The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.375 dated 01.11.2020 registered under Sections 379 and 34 IPC at Police Station Chandhut, Tehsil and District Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in other three cases, petitioner has been acquitted. There is no other case except the present case. Even the matter has been resolved between the parties and the complainant Naresh Kumar has submitted an affidavit (Annexure P-2).

Vide order dated 14.01.2021, notice of motion was issued and interim anticipatory bail was granted.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jeet Ram states that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of Investigating Officer and he is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 14.01.2021 is made absolute. However, petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
