GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner-Vishal Soni and Manpreet Singh Khara @ Manpreet Khara, stated to be aged 41 & 51 years respectively, has filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the official respondents No.3 to 8 for removing the seal (Annexure P-10) as noticed in GDR No.24 dated 24.10.2020 (Annexure P-11) affixed on the lock of the shop of the petitioners.

Records of the case show that on 21.01.2021, notice of motion was issued by this Court. In response thereto, learned State counsel appearing for respondents No.1 to 3, on instructions from ASI Sukhdev Singh, submits that the petition has become infructuous as the seal as mentioned in the prayer

clause of the writ petition, has been removed. Learned State counsel further submits that vide GDR Nos.25 & 28 dated 02.03.2021, the seal affixed on lock of the shop of the petitioners, has been opened.

Learned counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the above said contention made by learned State counsel. He further submits that in case, the petitioners have any grievance, he would file a separate representation which shall be decided by the concerned authority in accordance with law.

Ordered accordingly.

Civil Writ Petition stands disposed of as having become infructuous.
