The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner Ashok Kumar for issuance of direction to the respondents for registration of FIR against the accused-persons, who had inflicted injuries on his person on 12.10.2020. He has specified the names of the accused-persons in paragraph no.2 of the petition and also had stated in paragraph no.4 of the same, about the detail of the injuries found on his person.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that even though, the occurrence has been caused and serious injuries has been inflicted on his person but no FIR has been registered by the respondents against the assailants. Even representation dated 10.12.2020 (Annexure P-3) has been filed, but no action has been initiated upon the same.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and gives assurance about initiation of action on the representation dated 10.12.2020, in accordance with law.

In view of the submission so made and the assurance so given by the learned State Counsel, the present petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to official respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the grievance of the petitioner, in view of the representation dated 10.12.2020, copy whereof is Annexure P-3 and to initiate action upon the same, in accordance with law(if so required), within a period of two months from today onwards.

However, these observations are circumscribed, only for the purposes of disposal of the present petition, without prejudice to the rights of the parties, to be adjudicated in any civil or criminal proceedings.

The present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
