This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 4 to conduct investigation through respondent No.3-CBI or respondent No.4-Enforcement Directorate or from any independent investigation agency and for transfer of investigation in case FIR No.212 dated 17.12.2020 under Sections 384 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Navi Baradari, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, to respondent No.3 or respondent No.4 with further prayer for protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 18.12.2020 to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh, copy of which is available

At the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

At this juncture, Mr. Rajwinder Singh Bains, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.12.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to look into and dispose of representation dated 18.12.2020 (Annexure P/6), in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
