LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioners seek direction to respondent no.2 to recommend the case of the petitioners for appointment to the post of Male Constable (General Duty) as both of them have secured marks equal to the last candidate whose name has been recommended for appointment i.e. 61.25 marks.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondent no.2 in October 2020 recommended 127 candidates for appointment. The petitioners' who belong to BC(B) category, have secured marks equal to the last recommended candidate as mentioned above. Furthermore, many of the

said 127 candidates have refused to join on the post in question. Learned counsel refers to Annexure P-7 to P-12 in this regard. Learned counsel also refers to order dated 07.09.2020 in CWP-13728-2020 (Annexure P-13), passed in the case of a similarly situated petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Saurabh Mohunta, D.AG., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents and does not raise any serious objection for a consideration of the petitioners' grievance by the authorities in the given factual matrix.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to treat the present writ petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioners and consider the same expeditiously, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are found eligible, appointment be offered within a period of two weeks thereafter. In case of a decision adverse to the petitioners, the same be by way of a speaking order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
