Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 315 dated 04.10.2020 registered under Sections 148, 307, 323, 452, 506, 149 IPC, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959 (Section 120-B IPC added later on) at Police Station Aasauda, District Jhajjar.

Vide order dated 06.01.2021, passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 06.01.2021 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Rohtash Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 06.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
