Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.90 dated 2.6.2020 under Sections 306, 201 IPC registered at Police Station Goraya, District Jalandhar.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is behind bars from the last about one year and has been falsely implicated in the present case. He vehemently contends that merely by reading of the FIR, no offence under Section 306 IPC is made out, as from the allegations narrated, no conclusion can be drawn that the petitioner has abated suicide of the deceased-Varinder Kaur.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner was arrested on 20.8.2020 and total 16 prosecution witnesses have to be examined and none has been examined so far.

In the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case and keeping in view the custody period of the petitioner, I find that the petitioner has made out a case for grant for regular bail. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. Nothing said herein shall be treated as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
