The petitioners were employed as Data Entry Operators through an Outsourced Agency. The Outsourced Agency, which is a Private enterprise, has dispensed with the services of the petitioners. The petitioners by filing the present writ petition claim a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents (State of Haryana) to allow the petitioners to continue in service.

This Court in CWP-17454-2020 titled as Naresh Kumar and others Vs. Haryana State Warehousing Corporation and others, decided on 02.12.2020 has already held that in such circumstances, the writ petition by such employees is not maintainable. There is no relationship of employer and employee between the petitioners and State of Haryana or its instrumentalities.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the writ petition is disposed of by relegating them to the alternative remedy.
