This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to arrest respondents No.4 to 6 and proceed against them in accordance with law, in case FIR No.62 dated 12.03.2018 under Section 420 IPC and Section 4 of Prize Chits and Money Circulation Schemes (Banning) Act, 1978, registered at Police Station City Rajpura, District Patiala and to conduct fair investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 02.12.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Patiala, District Patiala, copy of which is available on record as Annexure P/2, but no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, District Patiala, to look into and dispose of representation dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P/2), in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
