Case has been heard through video conferencing on account of
COVID-19 Pandemic.

Counsel for the petitioner, at the outset, submits that during the
pendency of the petition, a notification dated 23.2.2021 has been issued
bifurcating the Gram Panchayat. He submits that he may be allowed to
withdraw the instant petition with liberty to impugn the said notification.

Mr. Bahri has vehemently opposed the aforesaid prayer.
According to him, petitioner had no locus standi to file the writ petition. He
has concealed a number of facts from the Court such as, he was removed
from the post of Sarpanch; he impugned the said order; his writ petition and
LPA was dismissed.

At this stage, we do not find it appropriate to go into the rival

petitioner to file a fresh petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Needless to observe that in case he has any fresh cause of action, he may avail appropriate remedy, if so advised and if maintainable.
