Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.9 dated 19.11.2020 registered under Sections 8 and 12 of POCSO Act, 2012 and Sections 323, 34, 354, 354-D, 452, 506 IPC (lateron Section 8 of POCSO Act, 2012 and Sections 323, 34, 354, 452 and 506 IPC deleted) at Women Police Station Gohana, District Sonipat.

By virtue of the order dated 28.6.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Sudesh has endorsed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 28.6.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
