Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner

seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.577 dated 02.12.2019 registered

at Police Station S.G.M. Nagar (Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Nagar),

Faridabad, District Faridabad under Sections 420, 489-B and 489-C IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner was apprehended on the spot giving fake currency note of Rs.200/- to a shop keeper. The petitioner has been in custody since 07.12.2019. It is further stated that the challan has been presented.

At this stage, learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid factual position. However, he states that out of nine witnesses, none has been examined so far.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

The petitioner has been in custody since 07.12.2019. Trial of the case would take time to conclude. Therefore, no useful purpose would

be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits, lest it should prejudice the case of either side, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
