GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.215 dated 01.12.2020 at Police Station Nurpur Bedi, District Ropar, under Sections 307/324/323/148/149 IPC.

2. Although as per the FIR, the petitioner is attributed a blow with 'kirpan' on the head of the injured Gurpreet Singh, but the matter is stated to have been amicably resolved amongst the parties. Mr. Naveen Batra, Advocate, who is representing the complainant, has endorsed the factum of compromise and has stated that he has no objection in case the petitioner is granted bail.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has informed that the petitioner has been behind bars since the last about 7 months and that he is not wanted in any other case.

4. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties and while particularly bearing in mind that the matter is stated to have been resolved amicably amongst the parties and while also noticing that the petitioner has been behind bars for a substantial period of about 7 months, further detention of the petitioner will not serve any useful purpose. The petition, as such, is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.
