This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.155 dated 27.08.2020 under Sections 120-B, 380 and 454 IPC, registered at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 19.12.2020 to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, copy of which is available on record as Annexure P/2, but no action has been taken.

At the asking of Court, Mr. H.S. Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into and dispose of representation dated 19.12.2020 (Annexure P/2), in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
