1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.
2. After arguing for some time and in view of stand of learned State Counsel that the trial is at the conclusion stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the instant petition at this stage and would be satisfied, if the learned trial Court is directed to conclude the trial in a time bound manner, while granting liberty to the petitioner to move a fresh petition for bail in the eventuality of the trial not being concluded within the time to be stipulated by this Court.
3. Learned State Counsel submits that the learned trial Court be directed to conclude the trial within 03 months in view of the same being at the conclusion stage.
4. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties and in view of the stand of the learned State Counsel, I accept the prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner and while disposing

of the petition as not pressed at this stage, direct the learned trial Court to conclude the trial at the earliest and in any case within 03 months from today, while granting liberty to the petitioner to move a fresh petition for grant of bail in the eventuality of non conclusion of the trial within the stipulated period of time.

5. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
