This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner having successfully negotiated a recruitment process is a selected candidate for the post of Primary Teacher under the Education Department, State of Haryana.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that at the time of allocation of the place of posting/district, due consideration has not been given to the option exercised by the petitioner whereas candidates lower in merit have been accommodated.

Counsel submits that similarly aggrieved candidates filed CWP No.31823 of 2019 (Monika and others vs. State of Haryana) and which was disposed of on 02.11.2019 with a direction to the concerned authority to take a decision on the representations that had been filed by the petitioners therein. Counsel further adverts to the order dated 03.02.2020 (Annexure

P.7) whereby the necessary relief has been granted by the Director,

Elementary Education, State of Haryana to the petitioners in CWP No.31823 of 2019.

Parity of treatment is sought.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition with a direction to the 2nd respondent i.e. Director, Elementary Education, Haryana to examine the grievance of the petitioner against the backdrop of a legal notice dated 05.12.2020 (Annexure P-9) which is stated to have already been served.

A final decision in the matter be taken expeditiously and in any case within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Disposed of.
