The petitioner is a works contractor. He was allotted certain civil works vide allotment dated 15.12.2017. It is his case that work was completed on 15.05.2020 before the extended date provided for completion. The completion certificate has also been issued by the competent authority, yet, complete payment has not been released till date. Even Legal Notice dated 01.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) has not been responded to.

In view of the nature of the relief sought and the order proposed to be passed, issuance of notice to the respondents is not essential.

Thus, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide the pending Legal Notice dated 01.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously and in any case not later than four weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case it is found that complete payments have not been released, the balance be released within ten days thereafter.
