The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for grant of eight weeks emergency parole on medical ground.

Learned counsel refers to the medical treatment chart of the petitioner from the Dispensary, District Jail, Barnala (Annexure P-1) and states that the petitioner is suffering from severe pulmonary disease.

Heard.

In pursuance of order dated 11.01.2021, learned State counsel has filed medical status report and custody certificate of convict Shinder Singh-petitioner and the same are taken on record. As per the medical status report, the petitioner was referred to Guru Gobind Singh Medical College and Hospital, Faridkot and was then referred back to Civil Hospital, Bathinda for surgery.

In view of the health condition of the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted eight weeks emergency parole, subject to his furnishing indemnity bonds with two local sureties to the satisfaction of the competent authority/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities on the date and time to be notified by the releasing Court/Duty Magistrate.
