The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0409 dated 01.10.2020 registered under Sections 452, 506, 427, 148, 149 and later on added Section 323 IPC, at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar City.

Notice of motion was issued on 11.01.2021 on the basis of compromise dated 27.12.2020 entered into between the parties.

Following order was passed on 11.01.2021:-

"The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has otherwise been compromised between the parties. He refers to the compromise deed dated 27.12.2020 (Annexure P-5).

Notice of motion for 09.04.2021.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when directed by the investigating agency and shall abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C
