1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner concedes that the original certificate was submitted by the petitioner to the CBSE Authorities only on 07.01.2021. In the circumstances, the contempt petition is pre-mature as the amended certificate was to be issued by incorporating the petitioner's surname within 02 weeks from the date of return of original certificate by the petitioner.

3. Faced with the aforementioned situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the contempt petition, at this stage, with liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition, if the circumstances of the case so warrant.

4. In view of the position as noted above, the contempt petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, at this stage, with the liberty as prayed for.
