The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to officials respondent No.1 to 3 to provide security to the life and liberty of the petitioner and their family members from the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5 and for issuance of a direction for registration of a case/FIR against them as they have inflicted several injuries on the petitioner and his wife and also snatched her gold ornaments.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that before approaching this Court, several representations had been submitted but no action has been taken by the police authorities. He submits that the petitioner will be

satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into representation (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner.

The prayer made by the petitioner is just and proper.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana – respondent No.2 to examine the representation (Annexure P-2) and take suitable action thereon as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation (Annexure P-2) be communicated to respondent No.2 to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
