Pursuant to the order dated January 08, 2021, admitting the petitioners to interim bail in respect of the FIR registered alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 379-B of the IPC, learned counsel for the State submits that as per his instructions, the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, this petition has been rendered infructuous and disposed of.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, they would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon them.

Naturally, if the complainant is aggrieved in any manner, of lack of

proper investigation, she would be always at liberty to avail of her remedy as per law.
