Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.303 dated 02.12.2020 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 07.01.2021: -

“...Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the FIR has been registered on a complaint made by one Ravi Kumar with the allegations that trucks and dumpers are entering into the State of Haryana after loading sand, stone etc. from Himachal Pradesh and they are using forged bills. Upon this, the police swung into

action and impounded two trucks, bearing registration Nos.HR-58-B-0631 and HR-58-B-8268. Thereafter, the owners of the trucks were arrested and forged bills and other documents were recovered. It is further submitted that allegation against the petitioner is that he has prepared the said forged bills.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sumit Jain, Addl. AG, Haryana, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that recovery of a laptop is to be effected from the petitioner...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Parveen Kumar, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.01.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
