The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in cross case vide DDR No.19 dated 28.09.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 427, 34 IPC (Section 326 IPC was added later on) in FIR No.50 dated 27.09.2020 under Sections 307, 323, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Arif Ke, District Ferozepur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 07.01.2021 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Deepika Rani, does

not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no more required, present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.01.2021 is made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
