This is an application that has been filed seeking withdrawal of the main case fixed for hearing on 13.09.2021 as the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner herein would also contend that by an order dated 25.01.2019, he had been directed to deposit an amount of Rs.25000/- as litigation expenses with the Registry, which order had been complied with by the petitioner. As the matter has been compromised, the petitioner herein seeks the refund of the litigation expenses that stand deposited in terms of Clause-6 of the Panchayati compromise arrived at between the parties.

Keeping in view the development after the filing of the petition, as noticed above, the main case is preponed for hearing today. The petition is dismissed withdrawn on account of the compromise between the parties and the quashing petition having been filed. The Registry is directed to refund the amount of Rs.25,000/- which stand deposited as litigation expenses to the counsel for the petitioner herein as prayed.

The misc. applications are allowed accordingly.
