Through this writ petition, the petitioner has prayed for issuance of a writ of mandamus by way of directions to the official respondent Nos.1 and 2 to provide adequate security to protect his life and liberty from respondent Nos.3 and 4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner is a Chairman in Non Government Organization, namely, Sarv Sukh Sewa Mission, who is facing threats to his life and liberty. He submits that respondent Nos.3 and 4 misbehaved with the petitioner and therefore, he deserves to be protected. He has invited the attention of the Court to the representation dated 14.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) given by the petitioner to Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds no merit in the present writ petition. A perusal of the representation reveals that the alleged incident of misbehaviour took place on 22.10.2020 and as per the averments, the petitioner himself went to the Police Station with two

officers. The representation does not contain any averment regarding the alleged threats or prayer for providing the police protection.

Resultantly, this Court finds that the bald averments as contained in the writ petition are not enough for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
