This is petition filed under Section 438 C.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 294 dated 17.12.2020 registered under Sections 120 B, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station Jui Kalan, PS Bhiwani, District Bhiwani.

Notice of motion was issued to State. Vide order 8.1.2021, petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel states that petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view thereof, petition is allowed. Order dated 8.1.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner is made absolute. However, petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by investigating agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

Mr. Malik, learned DAG Haryana states that the Investigating Officer has written to Education Department to supply the original record pertaining to affiliation of petitioner's school in respect of 9th and 10th classes. The Education Department has replied stating that the said record is not presently traceable.

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Mr. Malik, learned DAG Haryana states that petitioner may be required to be associated with investigation as and when said record is made available to Investigating Officer by Education Department.

Mr. Aggarwal, learned senior counsel for petitioner assures that petitioner would cooperate with Investigating Officer in such eventuality.
