SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the son of the petitioner has been involved by the local police in three different FIRs on 14.12.2020 and the petitioner is not named as an accused in any of the said cases. However, the local police have illegally occupied his house and are not letting him enter the same. He submits that the petitioner is a senior citizen and is on medication for age related ailments. Before approaching this Court, the petitioner moved a representation dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) seeking protection to his life and liberty. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned authority to look into his representation.

Without examining the allegations levelled in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur – respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 16.12.2020 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation (Annexure P-1) be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
