By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 221 dated 5.12.2020 registered under Section 420 IPC at Police Station Sahnewal, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued. Vide order dated 8.1.2021, petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel states that petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that the matter has been compromised between the parties and in view of compromise, 2 petitions i.e. CRM-M-13312-2021 and CRM-M-14467-2021 for quashing the FIRs against petitioner and complainant have been filed.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 8.1.2021 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner is made absolute. However petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
