The petitioner, who is having some dispute with his wife i.e. respondent No.5 asserts that respondent No.6, namely, Constable Boota Singh and respondent No.8, namely, Sukhdev Singh Virk, SP(D), Barnala along with respondent No.7, namely, Satinder Pal Singh @ Lucky are pressurizing him to effect compromise as per the terms of petitioner's wife i.e. respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he apprehends threat to his life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 and although he had submitted a representation dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-2), but to no avail.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and while refraining from making any expression as regards veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to look into the matter and to examine the alleged threat perception and

to dispose of the representation dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law expeditiously.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 02.12.2020 (Annexure P-2) be sent to respondent No.3 - Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala so as to enable him to do the needful at the earliest.
