The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.191 dated 14.7.2019 registered under Sections 307, 325, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 at Police Station Sadar Dhuri District Sangrur.

FIR was registered at the instance of Satnam Singh @ Kaka. As per allegations of the complainant, when he was talking to his friend at about 4.00 P.M. on 13.7.2019, the petitioner along with Ramesh @ Kaka, Sanju, Sunny and Mitha

came there in a car. 4-5 persons also came there on two motorcycles. The occupants of the car were armed with iron rods and baseballs. The motorcyclists were armed with *lathis* and dandas. All attacked the complainant. The complainant fell down. When the complainant tried to run, then Sanju exhorted that he should not be allowed to go. He inflicted iron rod blow at the back of head of the complainant. Ramesh @ Kaka and Sunny encircled the complainant and Mitha gave a baseball blow on his right leg. Left leg of the complainant was broken. Then the petitioner gave a rod blow on the knee of left leg and on right leg of the complainant. Kaka, Sunny and unknown persons also inflicted injuries with baseballs.

As per medico legal report, following injuries were found on the person of the injured complainant.

- “1. C/o of pain right elbow joint. Advised ortho opinion.
2. C/o pain left arm below elbow joint. Advised ortho opinion.
3. C/o pain left leg, mid aspect. Advised ortho opinion.
4. C/o pain right leg. Advised ortho opinion.
5. LW wound 7 cm x 0.5 cm out left Parietocipital area of scalp. Advised opinion.
6. Bleeding from left ear. Advised opinion.
7. C/o pain right costal area, lateral side. Advised

opinion.”

Perusal of the aforesaid medico legal report would show that injury No.1 to 4 are complaint of pain. Injury No.5 is the lacerated wound 7 cm x 0.5 cm out left parietocipital area of scalp. This injury has been declared as dangerous to life. Injuries No.1, 3, 4, 5 and 6 have been found to be grievous in nature.

Co-accused Sunny has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 01.05.2020 passed in CRM-M No.52590 of 2019. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks parity with the co-accused Sunny on the ground that at the most the petitioner is author of grievous injury and is in custody since 15.04.2020.

Per contra, learned State counsel opposed the bail on the ground that charges have already been framed and 25.01.2021 is the date fixed for prosecution evidence. Petitioner is also involved in three more cases.

In view of aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, keeping in view the nature of injuries allegedly inflicted by the petitioner and his custody since 15.04.2020, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on regular bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing

adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
