The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the petitioner was declared a proclaimed offender in the case vide order dated 18.02.2015 passed by the trial Court, he would like to challenge the said order in a separate proceeding.

He further submits that the co-accused in the case have already been acquitted by the trial Court vide judgment dated 05.08.2017. When the proceedings declaring the petitioner as proclaimed offender were conducted, he was living abroad. Now, he has returned to India and would challenge the said order dated 18.02.2015 by way of separate proceedings. Therefore, he be

permitted to withdraw the present petition, however, with liberty to assail the said order dated 18.02.2015 by way of separate proceedings.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
