The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 37 dated 03.11.2020, under Sections 120-B, 34, 379-A of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station GRP Jind, District GRP Ambala Cantt.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the FIR is the outcome of misunderstanding between friends. It was alleged in the FIR that the car of the complainant had been snatched. He also contends that the matter has been compromised with the intervention of the respectable. He has referred to the copy of the compromise at Annexure P2. He further contends that in the petition bearing CRM-M No.44138 of 2020 preferred by the petitioners for quashing of the FIR on the basis of the compromise, notice has been issued by this Court and the parties have been directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq/Duty Magistrate for recording their statements.

This Court, by the order dated 08.01.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation

and in the event of their arrest, they were to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh, states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 08.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
