Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 115 CPC for setting aside the impugned order dated 15.12.2020 (P-1), passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Rajpura, whereby the application of the respondent under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC was allowed and plaint of the petitioner has been rejected.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to grant him 4 (four) weeks' more time for payment of *ad valorem* Court fee in terms of the impugned order dated 15.12.2020 (P-1).

Prayer seems to be justified.

Learned trial Court will accept the *ad valorem* Court fee in case the same is paid within 4 (four) weeks' from today.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
