“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not involved in any other case and he was arrested along with the co-accused Ajay Sharma along with 04 Kgs and 200 gms of Charas, which falls in commercial quantity.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is in custody for the last about 01 year and 09 months and 08 days; charges have been framed in this case on 05.10.2019 and the trial is not progressing due to COVID-19 situation in the country.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that co-accused Ajay Sharma has already been granted concession of interim bail, vide order dated 08.12.2020 passed by this Court in CRM-M-17101-2020.
