The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking the writ in the nature of *Habeas Corpus* for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 5 for getting released the sister of the petitioner from the illegal detention of respondents No. 6 to 10 and to take legal action against them.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.4 to look into the representation dated 28.12.2020 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner.
