This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.5 to 8 and to conduct fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.124 dated 31.10.2018 under Sections 323, 341 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Rahon, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representation on 11.12.2020 to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District S.B.S. Nagar, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/7, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, District S.B.S. Nagar, to look into and decide representation dated 11.12.2020 (Annexure P/7) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
