1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.135 dated 23.09.2019 registered under Sections 323, 341, 427 and 506 of IPC, 1860 and 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, 1959 (later deleted by the police) registered at Police Station P.S. Sadar Jalandhar, District Police Commissionerate Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising thereto on the basis of compromise Annexure P-2 dated 24.12.2020.

3. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl.A.G. Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions from ASI Jasbir Chand states that untraced report has been prepared by SI Kamal Jeet on 15.02.2020 and in case some time is granted, the same would be filed before the learned trial Court while Mr. Ravinder Singh, Advocate,

objection if the aforementioned FIR and all consequential proceedings arising thereto are quashed on the basis of compromise Annexure P-2 dated 24.12.2020.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the circumstances, he does not press the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. at this stage and the same may be disposed of as such while directing the Commissioner of Police, District Jalandhar to ensure filing of the untraced report before the learned trial Court within a stipulated period of time.

5. In view of the position as noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is disposed of as not pressed at this stage while directing the Commissioner of Police, District Jalandhar to ensure filing of untraced report before the learned trial Court within two weeks from today. Needless to mention, if the circumstances of the case so warrant, it would be open to the petitioner to take out appropriate proceedings in accordance with law against orders passed by the learned trial Court on the untraced report.

6. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
